**ITEMS DISCUSSED:**

- 2021 Energized Community Grant (NOPEC)
  - Crowl – this grant provides funds to communities for energy savings or energy infrastructure projects – City Administration is proposing this grant be used to install additional solar powered lighting on the far east side
  
  - Mayor – this will be the City’s fourth round for this funding (about \$7,000) – the City’s first grant project was the solar lighting at the bus shelters, followed by two personal device charging tables at the pool and Community Center, and six free-standing solar lampposts between Townsend and Grand Park – this round will allow, hopefully, for four additional lampposts on Avon and Euclid – there is little to no lighting mid-block on these streets as the streets run north, south and the grid runs east, west
  
- Appropriations
  - Crowl -- \$11,000 for a needed repair to the Parking Garage elevator; \$5.00 for administrative fees necessary for the DRD
