

## Rules and Regulations Continued....

### Miscellaneous Items

- Lost items are kept for two weeks. After that time, they will be donated to a charitable organization.
- ORC 3781.55 allows breastfeeding in any location of public accommodation. Breast feeding is allowed on pool grounds. Breast feeding is not allowed while in the pool due to the Health Code.

### Disciplinary Action

- The Athens City Pool reserves the right to make discretionary adjustments to disciplinary action depending upon the circumstances. Whenever misconduct involves a minor, their parent or guardian will be notified.

### Swim Test

- All individuals under the age of 14 or those who the Lifeguard deems necessary, must take a 25 yard swim test in order to use the diving board or lap lane pool.
- Failure to pass the swim test will result in the individual using the leisure pool and splash pad only.
- A swim test is not needed to use the slide or splash pad. Must be 48 inches tall to use slide.
- You can only take the swim test once per day.
- Upon passing the swim test, the individual will receive a colored wrist band to indicate they have passed.
- Successful completion of the swim test does not prevent you from having to take it again.

### Operational Information

#### Open Swim Hours:

Sunday - Friday.....12:00pm-7:00pm

Saturday.....11:00am-8:00pm

#### Adult Lap Swim Hours:

Monday - Friday.....8:00am-9:15am

Monday - Friday.....11:00am-11:45am (No 11am lap swim on Tues./Thurs.)

Saturday.....10:00am-10:45am

**\*\*Once open swim hours begin, patron must pay the daily admission fee or show membership in order to continue using the facility. Adult lap swim is open to individuals 18 years and older.**

## Rules and Regulations Continued..

### General Rules

31. Athens Arts, Parks, & Recreation or the City of Athens is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Patrons are encouraged to use the supplied lockers to keep their items safe.

32. Obey all Pool Staff at all times. All additional rules regarding the safety of pool patrons are at the Pool Staff's discretion.

33. Obey all other rules that are posted for the Splash Pad, Tot Pool, Diving Well and Slide.

34. Violators of the above rules and other safety rules are subject to expulsion for the season, or dismissal for the day.

### Slide Rules

1. All riders must be at least 48" tall.

2. Maximum rider weight is 300 pounds.

3. Non-swimmers are not permitted.

4. All riders must ride feet first while lying on their back with arms crossed their chest. Do not go down the slide head first. Do not sit up while riding the slide.

5. Riders must enter the slide in a sitting position and wait for instructions from the attendant stationed at the slide starter tub.

6. Do not propel yourself into the ride.

7. Only one rider at a time. Absolutely no trains or chains of riders are permitted.

8. No running, standing, kneeling, rotating, tumbling or stopping in the flume. Arms and hands must remain inside the flume at all times. Riders should remain in proper riding position until forward movement is terminated. At no time should the rider attempt to stand up while on the slide or prior to coming to a complete stop at the bottom of the slide.

9. No tubes, mats, or lifejackets are permitted on the waterslide.

10. No combs or foreign objects are allowed in pockets and no jewelry can be worn while riding the slide. No jeans or swim wear with exposed zippers, buckles, rivets or metal ornamentation; only approved swim suits allowed.

11. The line should form on the deck with one rider on each landing and one rider in the starter tub. Wait until landing area is clear before entering.

12. Riders must be in good health. Elderly persons, those suffering from heart disease, high blood pressure, epilepsy, or persons using prescription medication should consult with their physician before using this slide. Individuals with medical conditions including, but not limited to pregnancy, heart, or back problems should not ride.

13. Do not use this slide while under influence of alcohol or drugs.

14. No diving from the slide.

15. Leave bottom of slide promptly after entering.

16. Riders assumes all risk of injury due to misuse of this slide or failure to follow these rules.

**\*\*Remember to follow all other posted rules around the facility including the Splash Pad, Diving Boards and Tot Pool.**

## Rules and Regulations Continued..

### General Rules

7. Running, pushing, dunking, rowdy behavior, wrestling, or holding anyone under water is prohibited.
8. No floatation devices or dangerous toys are allowed.
9. Only U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets are allowed in the leisure or tot pools.
10. Pre-approved floatation devices are allowed in the tot pool only.
11. Smoking or vaping is not permitted on the grounds of the facility.
12. Alcohol or other illegal substances are not permitted on the grounds of the facility.
13. Dangerous weapons are not allowed.
14. Children between the ages of 4 and 17 must stay out of the pool during adult swim.
15. No more than one child under the age of 4 per adult during the 15-minute break periods. These accompanied children are allowed only in the leisure pool during the adult swim.
16. 15-minute break periods happen every hour at a quarter-till. During this time, only those 18 years or older may use the pool.
17. Lanes are for lap swimming only.
18. No glass is permitted in the facility.
19. All food, beverages or gum must be kept away from the immediate pool area. All trash and recycling must be placed in provided receptacles.
20. Outside food and drinks are allowed to be brought into the facility.
21. Individuals under the age of 14 must pass a 25-yard swim test in order to use the lap pool and diving well.
22. Children must be 48-inches tall in order to use the slide. No exceptions.
23. No free swimming in the diving area.
24. Patrons with open wounds, stiches or skin infections are not allowed in the pool. Please do not swim if you have diarrhea or for 2 weeks after symptoms subside.
25. Please shower before entering the pool.
26. Children must be under the age of 4 and accompanied by an adult to enter the locker rooms of the opposite sex. Family restrooms are located throughout the facility.
27. Skateboards, roller blades, scooters, hover-boards, drones, or bikes are not to be used while in the facility. Drones are not allowed near the facility.
28. Kick-boards are for lap swimming only. Swimmers may not hang on divider ropers or lap lines or play on ladders.
29. No pets allowed in the facility.
30. No goggles that cover the nose are allowed in the pool. No exceptions.

### Pool Rules and Regulations

#### General Rules

1. All persons entering the facility must present their membership pass at the front desk or pay the admission fee.
2. At all times, children under 9 years old must be under the direct care and supervision of a parent or guardian, or other responsible person of at least 14 years old.
3. Proper swimsuit attire must be worn while in the pool. Jeans, street clothes, thong bathing suits or non-swimming apparel is not permitted while in the pool.
4. A dress code exception for medical or religious reasons may be requested to the Pool Manager or Head Lifeguard on duty.
5. The Athens City Pool is a family-friendly facility. Foul language or other inappropriate gestures or actions will not be tolerated and are grounds for dismissal.
6. Diapered children are prohibited from entering the pool. Children who are not potty trained are required to wear swim diapers.
